The Bob Eatt Foundation was established in early 2013 out of the Estate of the Late Robert (Bob) Eatt, a generous man with a love for nature and ahead of his time in terms of waste management.

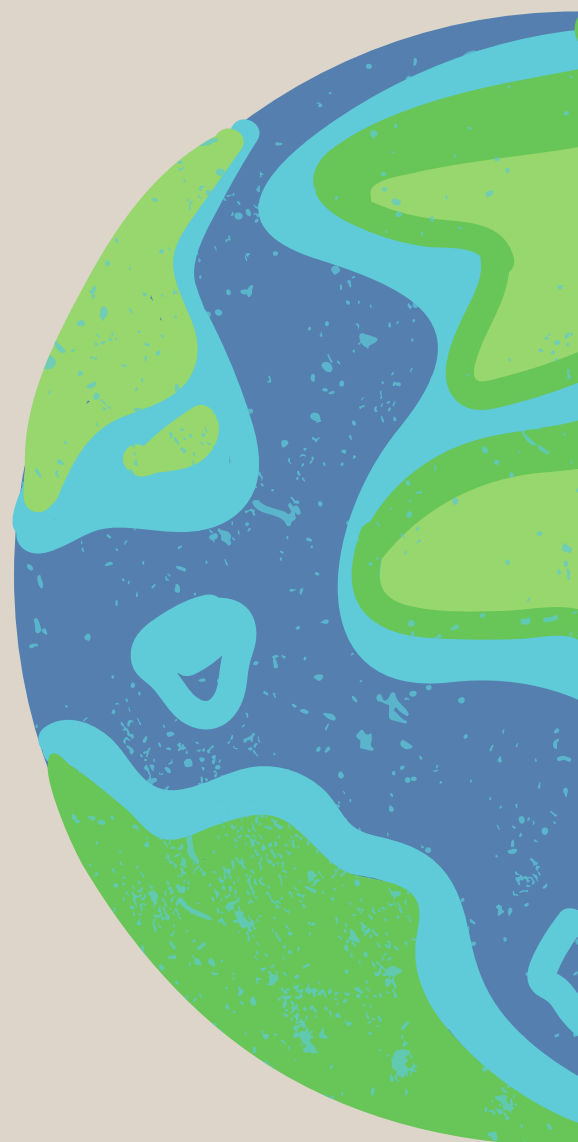
Plastic Oceans Australasia

Plastic Oceans Australasia (POA) is an impact not-for-profit organisation with the mission to change people's attitude to plastics within a generation.

POA works with community groups, businesses and individuals, offering professional education programs that are scientifically endorsed to inspire people to reduce plastic using self-led initiatives by working with others to eliminate plastic from supply chains and within the community, business and government entities.

POA believes education is essential to achieving transformational change and therefore works throughout Australasia delivering a solutions-based approach for schools, government agencies and community organisations.



The Award

The Bob Eat Foundation has joined forces with Plastic Oceans Australasia to recognise the work of schools across Australia and New Zealand who actively engage in initiatives and programs to reduce and improve their waste management systems.

The Award recognises efforts related to waste reduction and prevention through education including initiatives that promote waste avoidance and reduction to improve recycling systems, single-use plastic pollution and food waste reduction.



Criteria

School demonstrates minimisation of waste sent to landfill through workplace/operational waste reduction plans and audits as well as education initiatives that teach students to manage waste and engagement strategies that encourage teachers, parents and the wider community to participate in waste reduction efforts.
